Peppers plans in the event of a No-Deal Brexit outcome

As a leading supplier of hazardous area equipment, Peppers takes the certification on our product range very seriously. Following the UK electorate's decision to leave the EU we have been closely monitoring the situation and how discussions between the UK and EU have been progressing. Unfortunately there is a great deal of scaremongering and very little in the way of firm information on what will be required when/if an agreement is reached. Whilst it is disappointing that no firm trade deal has yet been agreed, Peppers have been in regular contact with our Notified Body, CSA Group, to ascertain what steps can be taken in the event of a no-deal situation.

We recognise that it is important that the certificate numbers associated with our products are maintained. To this extent we can confirm that, even in the event of a no-deal outcome, all of our certificate numbers will remain the same with the likely action being taken that our certificates will be up-issued and re-issued via an alternative EU based CSA Group Notified Body. This will ensure that Peppers Cables Glands Limited continues to supply product which is fully compliant with the ATEX Directive.

In the event that an agreement is reached between the UK and the EU, Peppers' existing certificates will remain in place throughout any agreed transition period. As always, Peppers is committed to ensuring our certificates are compliant to the latest editions of the appropriate 60079 series of standards and throughout this Brexit phase, we have continued to update our certificates to ensure their compliance.
